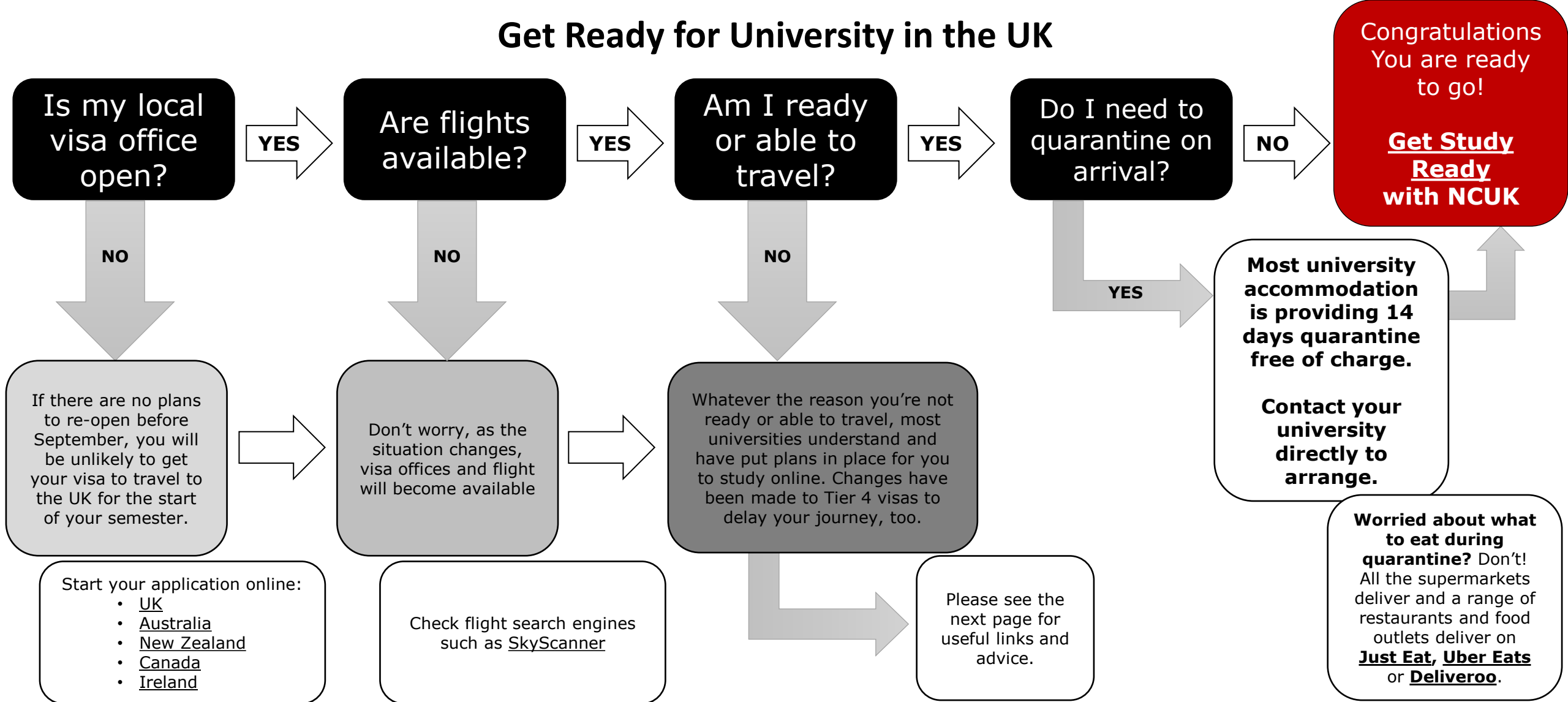

# How to register to start your studies online at our most popular universities in the UK

Follow these links to find out how to register online with your university for some or all of your first semester.

University	Advice
<b><u>University of Manchester</u></b>	Confirm your options through the Manchester Study Portal but please note there are some exceptions for some courses.
<b><u>University of Sheffield</u></b>	Confirm your intentions by completing the form from the link. Note there are some exceptions for some courses.
<b><u>University of Leeds</u></b>	Please speak to your School at the University. The University would prefer students to be on campus if possible. If it's not possible, all students must be on campus by 25 <sup>th</sup> January 2021.
<b><u>Leeds Beckett University</u></b>	Use the <u>Welcome and Registration System</u> to confirm your decision to study online and speak to your course tutor. Note, a small number of courses cannot accommodate online study but your tutor or contact at the International Office will advise you.
<b>University of Huddersfield</b>	Some courses are planning later Autumn start dates, and, in many cases, they will also be available to start in January 2020. If you are worried about this please contact <a href="mailto:international.office@hud.ac.uk">international.office@hud.ac.uk</a> or one of the Regional Offices. General guidance can be found <u>here</u> .
<b>Aston University</b>	Terms starts on 21 <sup>st</sup> September but if you can attend the University, arrangements will be made for you to study online. More <u>information can be found here</u> .
<b><u>University of Bristol</u></b>	For students taking a degree programme, you will either be able to join in your course at any time during the autumn term, or you will be able to join in January 2021. There are some exceptions to some courses listed on their <u>website here</u> .
<b>University of Birmingham</b>	You will either be able to join in your course at any time during the autumn term, or you will be able to join in January 2021. <u>Undergraduate</u> advice. <u>Postgraduate</u> advice.

<b>University of Birmingham</b>	You will either be able to join in your course at any time during the autumn term, or you will be able to join in January 2021. <a href="#">Undergraduate</a> advice. <a href="#">Postgraduate</a> advice.
<b><u>Queen Mary University of London</u></b>	From September 2020, Queen Mary will offer students world-class online provision, supplemented by face-to-face campus-based educational activities for those who are able to travel to our campuses.
<b><u>University of Kent</u></b>	All University teaching will be available online (where possible). Please contact your school if you need additional support.
<b>Manchester Metropolitan University</b>	Please complete <a href="#">this online form</a> and a member of University staff will contact you with further details.
<b><u>Liverpool John Moores University</u></b>	Students can apply to study online on a case by case basis and will find information on their CAS. New undergraduate students need to be in Liverpool by 21st September when new student induction will begin; teaching will commence on 24th September.

At present, the following universities are expecting all students to arrive on campus for the start of Semester 1.

- **University of Bradford** – International enrolment starts on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2020. Full information can be found in the [pre-arrival booklet](#). The University are reviewing options and NCUK will provide an update if this changes.
- **Sheffield Hallam University** – [Online registration](#) starts from 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020
- **University of Salford** – Courses will start on 28<sup>th</sup> September and further information can be found [here](#). You may be able to arrange a late registration date. Please contact the International Office ([international@salford.ac.uk](mailto:international@salford.ac.uk)) with your name, university ID (which starts @00) or UCAS number, course of study and email for advice.

The Australian border is currently closed, and students will be guided by their universities to study online, with personalised study plans. We will continue to monitor the border situation and latest advice ahead of the next semester start
Universities in <b>New Zealand</b>	The next university intake is Semester 1 in late February 2021. The New Zealand border is currently closed, and students will be guided by their universities to study online, with personalised study plans. We will continue to monitor the border situation and latest advice ahead of the next semester start
Universities in the <b>USA</b>	The next university intake begins in January 2021. All degree courses are currently delivered online.
University of Alberta, <b>Canada</b>	Semester 1 starts in early September and international students can study online if they wish. More information can be <a href="#">found here</a> .
St. George's University, <b>Grenada</b>	Semester 1 starts in August and all students will start their studies online. <a href="#">Read more here</a> .

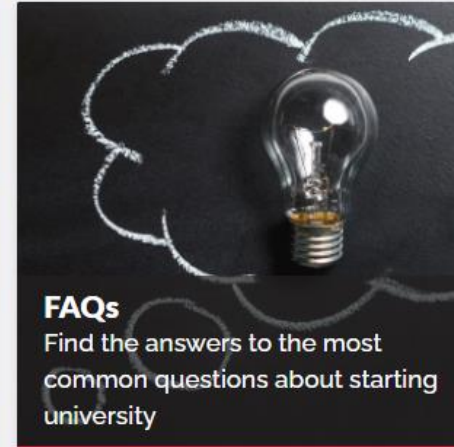
