You're nearly there!

Congratulations, you've nearly finished your NCUK qualification!

Read on to find out all you need to know about what happens next and how to confirm your university place.

When will my results be released?

Once you have completed your final assessment, your results will be released to you by NCUK. The exact date for this depends on which NCUK Study Centre you're studying at, so make sure you confirm this with your student counsellor.

Your chosen universities will receive your results a few days before you do, so they have time to check them over and see if you've met their conditions.

How do my chosen universities receive my results?

NCUK Universities:

These universities receive your results automatically, so you don't need to worry!

Universities outside of NCUK:

Your NCUK Study Centre will send your results directly to the universities once your final certificates have been released. This may mean that it takes a bit longer to have your final place confirmed with them.

Remember:

No matter what happens with your results, if you've passed your course NCUK will guarantee you a place at one of our excellent universities!*

University application outcomes:



The outcomes below highlight what will happen after receiving conditional offers from your firm/insurance choice universities as well as how NCUK can help you if you aren't successful in receiving an unconditional offer.

Your conditional firm choice becomes UNCONDITIONAL



Congratulations! You have met all of the requirements of your offer and your place at university is confirmed.

Your conditional firm choice offers you an ALTERNATIVE COURSE (change of course)



You have not met the requirements of your original offer BUT they can give you a place on a different course. You can choose to accept this or turn it down and progress to your insurance choice instead.

Your conditional insurance choice becomes UNCONDITIONAL



You have not met the requirements of your firm choice and it has become unsuccessful, but you have met the requirements of your insurance choice.

You have not met the requirements at your Firm or Insurance choice, and neither can make you an offer for an alternative course.



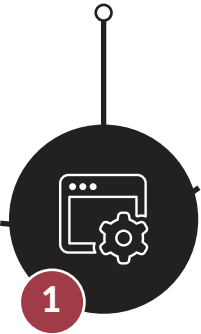
This is where NCUK steps in to help you find a place at another university through our UNIVERSITY APPLICATION SUPPORT service.

What is NCUK's University Application Service?

If you aren't accepted to your chosen university, don't worry! As long as you've successfully completed your NCUK qualification, we guarantee you a place at one of the NCUK Universities through our University Application Service.



You are automatically registered on to our University Application Service.



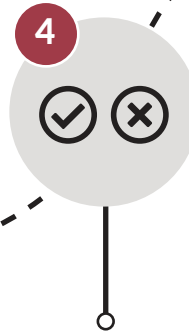
NCUK Universities take a look at your application and decide whether to offer you a place.



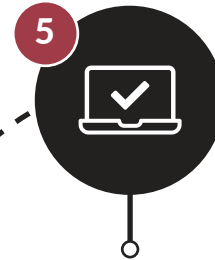
You receive an email from NCUK explaining the offers you have been made.



You choose to accept or decline the offers, and notify the NCUK Student Support Team.



NCUK notifies the university of the offer you wish to accept and helps you confirm the offer. For UK undergraduate applications, this will be done through UCAS Clearing.



Congratulations, you have an unconditional place at university!

Top Tip:

Remember to check your email inbox regularly to not miss any important correspondence from NCUK and the university about your offer!

Changing direction – alternative progression to university

During your time studying with NCUK, your plans may change and you may decide to study at a different university, choose a different course or may not have met the entry requirements needed to progress to your chosen university. No matter what happens, as long as you have successfully completed your NCUK qualification, we are here to help you get there with our University Application Service.

Have you changed your mind and want a place at a different university or degree course?

If you've changed your mind about which university you would like to progress to, or if you would like to switch your degree course, then you could take advantage of NCUK's University Application Service. This service not only allows you to switch degree course (to a suitable alternative) but also allows you to progress to another of the NCUK Universities which are located in the UK, Australia, New Zealand and the USA!*

Done better than anticipated and want to change your university choice?

You may think that you've done better than you thought and would like to use this opportunity to progress to another university. Our University Application Service can provide you with information on alternative university destinations that you may want to consider.

Didn't meet the entry requirements of your chosen university?

If you haven't met the entry requirements necessary to progress to your chosen university then don't worry, NCUK has you covered! Our University Application Service is here to help plan your next step towards gaining a place at an NCUK university. Contact us at student@ncuk.ac.uk.

No matter what position you are in, the NCUK Student Support Team is here to make sure that you are supported throughout the entire process and successfully progress to university.

*Changes to degree courses and university choices are subject to availability.

My university place is confirmed and I have an Unconditional Offer. What should I do now?

Make sure you keep checking your emails and follow any instructions from the university and your student counsellor at your NCUK Study Centre.

Once your place is confirmed, your university will need to issue you with the final documentation to confirm your offer of study so that you can apply for your visa. For example, in the UK this is called a CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance of Study) and is issued in addition to your unconditional offer letter. Australian universities provide you with a CoE (Confirmation of Enrolment).

Each university will have different steps that you must complete to receive all necessary documents in support of your visa application. Some will ask you to:

- Submit documents including your passport and high school transcripts.
- Submit copies of your bank statements.
- Pay a deposit and send proof of payment to the university.

Top Tip:

UK Universities may ask you to provide evidence of sufficient financial funds in order to get your CAS, so make sure that you have enough money in your bank account for 28 days before you apply for your CAS and visa.



What happens if I don't pass my course?

Don't panic – we can still help you if you don't pass your course!

Make sure you get in touch with your student counsellor or a member of the NCUK Student Support Team, who can help explain the following options:

- Progress to the NCUK International Year One, which guarantees you entry to the second year of a UK university degree. For more information on this, please visit: www.ncuk.ac.uk/ncuk-qualifications/ncuk-international-year-one/
- Complete a university foundation programme with one of NCUK's partner organisations

It might also be possible to retake your programme completely – please contact us to discuss this option.

FAQs

1. When are my results released?

This will depend on where you are studying. Check with your student counsellor for confirmation.

2. I can't log into UCAS Track. What should I do?

At certain times during the Summer, UCAS will be closed due to essential maintenance. Check that it is not one of these dates and if not, contact the NCUK Student Support Team who will be able to help you.

3. I've been rejected by my Firm choice, but really want to go there. Can I apply with the help of NCUK's University Application Service?

If you've missed your offer and haven't been made an alternative offer by that university, then they usually won't consider you again. If you are unsure and need help deciding what to do next, contact the NCUK Student Support Team who will be more than happy to help.

4. I've met the academic conditions of my offer, but I've missed my EAP grades. What happens now?

Some universities may allow you to take an IELTS or other approved English Language Test as proof of your English Language abilities. Speak to a member of the NCUK Student Support Team, who will be able to check this for you.

5. I haven't sent my results to my universities. Will they definitely receive them?

Absolutely. You don't need to worry about this – NCUK and your Study Centre will take care of this for you!



Study Abroad checklist

Now that your university offer is confirmed, your adventure of studying abroad is about to begin and so are the final steps of preparing yourself for leaving home and arriving at university. The checklist below will help you keep track of all the essentials you need to think of:

- Ensure you have a valid passport
- Get your offer confirmation letter from the University
- Make payment of your tuition fee deposit (if applicable)
- Check your emails regularly and look out for the University's Welcome guide and events
- Prepare and apply for your study visa
- Check your accommodation move-in dates and university term dates
- Plan your travel and register for the university's Airport Meet & Greet service
- Purchase travel insurance
- Make two copies of all travel documents & IDs
- Make a list of essential contact telephone numbers
- Start packing!
