

#### YEAR IN REVIEW

With the Covid-19 pandemic significantly impacting the international higher education sector, NCUK entered the 20/21 year with a 10% deduction in the number of students enrolled on its qualifications compared to 19/20. Despite the challenges of the pandemic, more than 1400+ students were placed at an NCUK University Partner with 95% of students being accepted into their first-or second-choice places at university. Because of the high calibre of NCUK students, this year's cohort received offers from top ranked NCUK Universities worldwide in popular study destinations such as the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, USA, the Caribbean and more.

NCUK's innovative approach to assessments and education provision throughout the pandemic has also been recognised internationally at two major international higher education award ceremonies:



## **VALUE**

#### Universities

Our students from 20/21 have generated approximately £25 million in tuition fee revenue for NCUK University Partners in 21/22 and will generate £68 million in tuition fee revenue over the duration of their university courses.

Unsurprisingly, the 20/21 cohort of student placements has seen a slight decrease compared to previous consecutive year-on-year increases, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.



#### **Delivery Partners**

NCUK students from 20/21 generated more than

#### The NCUK Global Network

Collectively, NCUK students from 20/21 will generate more than £97.5 million over the duration of their NCUK qualification and university degree course for our Delivery and University Partners.

For NCUK, the total income generated from student enrolment, university placements and Delivery Partner operating fees in 20/21 was £4.9 million.






## **VOLUME** AND DIVERSITY

Students from 85 nationalities were recruited onto NCUK qualifications in 20/21. NCUK continues to recruit a diverse mix of nationalities across its global network.



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
#### **Diversity by Qualification**

In 20/21, NCUK established 22 new Delivery Partners across 11 markets, entering 3 new markets (Tunisia, Oman, Sri Lanka):


